



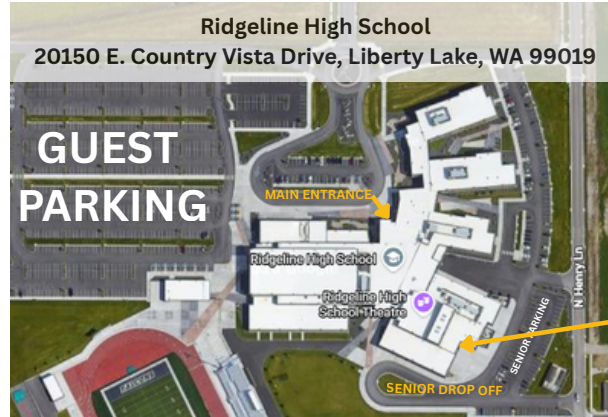

CLASS OF 2026 GRADUATION IS WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10TH AT 6PM AT RIDGELINE HIGH SCHOOL

- Graduates must arrive by **4:45 PM** at the RHS Theatre Entrance for Graduation Practice.
- Guests will enter through the RHS main entrance as early as **5:30 PM**.
- Theatre Doors will open at **5:45 PM** for guest to be seated.
- **Bring all your Family & Friends!** No tickets required to attend the graduation ceremony.
- **Parking is limited.** We encourage guests to carpool.
- There will be light refreshments in the RHS Commons following the graduation ceremony.

CAP DECORATING GUIDELINES

- Students who are wearing Caps & Gowns provided by CVVL **CANNOT** decorate the caps, as they need to be returned.
- Don't change the overall color of the black cap. Only the TOP of the cap can be decorated.
- **Keep it Classy, Kids!** Nothing 'offensive' or in violation of district policies.
- **Don't obstruct the view of others.** No decorations that rise up.
- Administration reserves the right to pull caps if deemed inappropriate.

DIPLOMA PICK UP STARTS THURSDAY, JUNE 11 AT CVVL

Seniors can pick up their actual diplomas at CVVL from Thursday, June 11 through Tuesday, June 16, between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM each school day.

To receive your diploma, you must return all CVSD-owned property, including textbooks, library books, calculators, Chromebooks, and chargers, or pay replacement fees for any missing or fined items. Additionally, students who borrowed a cap and gown must turn them in before their diploma can be released.

GRADUATION DRESS TIPS

We want you to look your best when you walk across the stage! Follow these quick tips to ensure your outfit and vibe are on point:

- **Prep Your Gown Early:** Take your gown out of the package several days before the ceremony. Hang it up and steam it in the bathroom while you take a hot shower to let the wrinkles fall out naturally. **Note:** Check the care label before attempting to iron it, as low heat is required for synthetic gown materials.
- **Dress for Success:** Treat graduation like a professional interview. Opt for sharp, semi-formal attire beneath your gown to match the significance of the achievement.
- **Prioritize Smart Footwear:** You will be walking across the main stage and navigating various steps or platforms. Choose comfortable, secure shoes that you can walk in confidently—avoid brand-new shoes or excessively high heels that might cause you to trip.
- **Hygiene Matters:** Graduation day is long, often warm, and involves a lot of close contact. Be sure to shower, wear a reliable deodorant, and consider bringing a travel-sized pack of mints so you feel confident and fresh from the group photos all the way to the final stage walk.

SETTLE ALL FINES & FEES*

Students with outstanding fines, fees, lost Chromebooks (\$300), CB Chargers (\$25), or lunch balance cannot receive their diploma nor have their transcripts forwarded to colleges or the military until all fees are settled. Be sure to check your student accounts and find out if you have outstanding balances at www.cvsd.org/apps/pages/payments.

SAVE \$ If You Lost Your Charger!

Purchase a replacement from Amazon.com for around \$10. Charger needs to be a 65-watt USB-C charger.
