Attendance	Minimum 120 Meetup Minutes each month. Weekly Mentor contact is encouraged.	Student must complete weekly assignments in each course and make 2-way contact with their advisor/mentor each week.

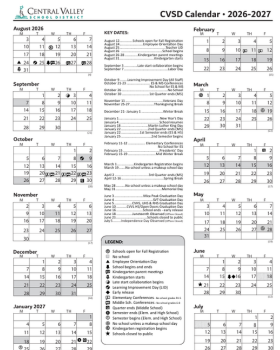


Pizza Cram runs from 12PM to 6PM on these dates:
